Test Administered using Fall Norms

%ile=Percentile Ranking	Percentile ranks provide information in terms of how a given child, class, or school performed in relation to other children, classes, or schools. A student in the first percentile is outranked by everyone and a student in the 99th percentile outranks everyone.
Stn=Stanine Rank	The stanine is another comparison that is computed statistically based on the bell curve, ranking students from one to nine, with five being average.

National Norms:	National Norms represent the estimated performance of all students in the United States at the relevant grade level. National Norms are not available for Grades 2 and 3.
Independent Norms:	Independent norms compare our students with other independent private schools throughout the country. This score is expected to drop by 1-2 stanines in each category, since many independent schools have very selective entry requirements, thus producing a very competitive norm pool.
